The December 2015 meeting of the Emery County School District Board of Education, held at Emery High School, was called to order at 6:00 PM by Board President Laurel Johansen. Other Board members present were Vice-President Royd Hatt, Marie Johnson, Sam Singleton and Julie Wilson. Superintendent Kirk Sitterud and Business Administrator Jared Black were also present.

WORKING SESSION

(B) Independent Auditor's Report: Rick Roberts and Gabe Miller of Kimball & Roberts presented, via video conference, the auditor's report for fiscal year 2015. Mr. Roberts mentioned his appreciation to the staff of the School District for their cooperation in preparing for and completing the audit. He then reviewed selections from the basic statements, notes and compliance sections of the financial report. He reported that the opinion of the audit firm is that revenues and expenditures for the District are fairly stated and reliable. Members of the Board thanked Mr. Roberts for his report.

REGULAR SESSION

At 7:00 pm, Mrs. Johansen welcomed all in attendance and led the audience in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board Action Item (B1): Board members considered the warrants, minutes of the November 2015 meeting, and financial reports for November 2015. A motion was made by Sam Singleton and seconded by Royd Hatt to approve the warrants, minutes and financial reports. The motion passed unanimously.

Board Action Item (B2): Board President Johansen mentioned that Rick Roberts and Gabe Miller had presented the Independent Auditor's Report for 2015 to the Board of Education during a working session prior to the regular meeting. Marie Johnson motioned to accept the report. Sam Singleton seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Board Action Item (B3): Superintendent Sitterud recommended to the Board that the following individuals be approved for the positions indicated:

Board Action Item (B4): A motion was made by Marie Johnson and seconded by Sam Singleton to approve the monthly meeting calendar for School Board Meetings in 2016. The motion passed unanimously. Board Action Item (B5): Ashley Jensen and five EHS students presented a request for approval to attend a national Youth Coalition Group leadership conference this February 1-5 in Washington DC. The trip is sponsored by Four Corners so there would be no expense to EHS or the District. The students each took a turn describing some of the reasons the trip would be beneficial. Members of the Board thanked them for their presentation.

Royd Hatt made a motion to approve the plan as presented. Marie Johnson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Report Item (C1): Principal Larry Davis presented the Board with copies of the 2015-16 EHS student handbook as well as his Board report. He thanked the Board for their ongoing support of Emery High School. He also expressed his appreciation for the faculty and staff at Emery High.

Principal Davis reviewed some of the accomplishments students at Emery High have achieved this year. He reviewed assessment and school grading results, indicating that he is happy with the academic achievements being made, and that the faculty and staff are committed to continual improvement. He reported on several positive initiatives and programs at EHS. He notified the Board of several upcoming events at the school. Board President Johansen thanked Principal Davis for his report, also expressing her appreciation for the dedication Mr. Davis has shown in his responsibilities at Emery High School. Other members of the Board expressed their appreciation to Principal Davis as well.

Report Item (C2): Mr. Black had nothing additional to report on.

Report Item (C3): Superintendent Kirk Sitterud mentioned that he has received a letter of intent to retire from Joann Farrer, Custodian at Emery High School. He also reviewed upcoming events with the Board.
