

The August 1st 2019 meeting of the Emery County School District Board of Education, held at the Emery County School District office, was called to order at 4:00 pm by Board President Tracey Johnson.  - a. Increased opportunities (bottom up)
6. Student Enrollment Forecasting
 - a. Help make decisions regarding staffing, building needs, etc.
7. Salaries
 - a. Make starting salaries more competitive (within state averages)
