<b>Cap &amp; Gown</b> <i>Pays for cap &amp; gown as part of annual graduation ceremony.</i>	\$ 100
<b>Credit Recovery</b> <i>Pays for software, personnel and other costs related to participation in the school credit recovery program.</i>	Per 1/4 Credit \$ 50
<b>Driver Education</b> <i>Pays for supplies, vehicle expenses, and personnel costs related to Driver Education.</i>	Behind-the-Wheel \$ 100 Classroom \$ 50 Total \$ 150
<b>Approved Out-of-State Travel</b> <i>Covers travel &amp; registration costs of school board approved out-of-state travel for students or student groups.</i>	\$ 1,500
<b>Dance Ticket</b> <i>Fee to enter school sponsored dances</i>	Per Ticket \$ 15
<b>Remediation</b> <i>Pays for personnel and supplies related to providing remediation opportunities.</i>	Per Course, Week 1 \$ 15 Per Course, Week 2+ \$ 30
<b>Sterling Scholar</b> <i>Costs related to participation in Sterling Scholar, including supplies &amp; personnel</i>	\$ 50
<b>Summer Remediation</b> <i>Pays for personnel and supplies related to providing summer remediation opportunities.</i>	Per Course \$ 100
<b>Welding Kit</b> <i>Cost of purchase for an individual welding kit. The kit is kept by the student for future use.</i>	\$ 150
<b>Machinist Kit</b> <i>Cost of purchase for an individual machinist kit. The kit is kept by the student for future use.</i>	\$ 85
